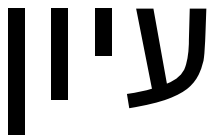

Guest Speaker: Maryrita Wieners

Maryrita Wieners was curious about Judaism since her teenage years, but on the way to finding her spiritual home, she was part of her Catholic family, a member of the Sisters of St. Joseph (a Catholic religious women’s community), a Catholic School teacher, and a coordinator of Liturgy at a large Roman Catholic parish in DC.

Like Abraham and Ruth, leaving one faith community and searching for a new community in which to live her spiritual identity, Maryrita found her way to Oseh Shalom—traveling that journey with her husband Dan Glaser who was also seeking a community where he could find joy in Judaism.
